VAS Competitions: SENIOR/OPEN/JUNIOR COOKERY

RULES & REGULATIONS: for CLASSES Open - 30 & 31 Junior - 21 & 22

1. This competition follows the show-group-state level of competition.
2. An exhibitor, having won at a Show, will bake another entry in the Group Final (the group final will be held at Tyrendarra, 8th February, 2020). The winner will then be required to bake a further entry for the State Final at the next Royal Melbourne Show.
3. Exhibitors are to follow the recipe and specifications.
4. An exhibitor having won at show/field day level is not eligible to enter any other show/field day until after the Group judging, when, if not the winning entry, can compete further.
5. An exhibitor is only eligible to represent one Group in the State Final.
6. Each entry must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
7. If for any reason a winner is unable to compete at Group or State Final level then the second placegetter is eligible to enter.

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
